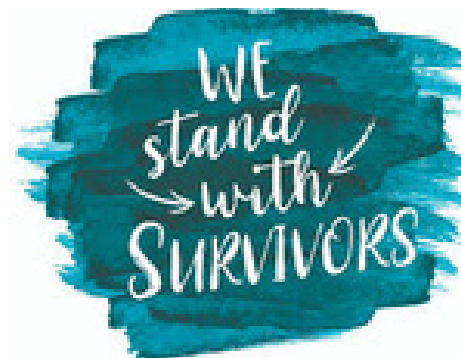

## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- 18 years or older
- An email address or phone contact
- Provide consent to be involved in study
- Been exposed to unwanted sexual experiences while enrolled at your UC
- Available and able to participate in an in-person or Zoom interview (~90 mins)

## PARTICIPANTS WILL RECEIVE

- Campus and community support information and referrals
- All information shared will be kept as confidential as possible
- Interviews conducted in private by trauma-informed researchers
- Receive a \$50 gift card for your time
